CONDOLENCES

On 25 November and 1 December, we lost two brothers who recently graduated from their Haggai Leadership training due to accidents. The Haggai National Board and the Haggai Family extend their condolences to both families.

Brother Samuel Ezra was a 21-year-old student who died in a motorbike accident on 25 November. His body was flown to Sarawak for burial.

Brother Lew Kim Wah was 56 years old, a church elder of Glorious Grace Presbyterian Church, Kuantan, who died in a head-on collision with a lorry. On 1 December, seven church members from Glorious Grace Presbyterian Church, Kuantan were traveling to Johor Bahru for a mission event. On their return trip, they met in a head-on accident with a lorry near Mersing road. Two elders died. One of them was a participant, Lew Kim Wah, who just graduated on 20 November from the East Coast Haggai Chinese National Seminar.

The other elder who passed away, Choong Yee Hoong, was very supportive of Haggai and sent six participants for the Haggai Seminar. The loss of these two elders is a big loss to Kuantan and 7979 Mission works in the East Coast.

TESTIMONY

Our Journey in London Steven Loh

This year September 2023 was a special occasion for our family to meet together in London. We visited many old churches, one of the oldest was St. Alban Cathedral, having 1,600 years of history. Today, it became one of the major tourist attraction with lots of visitors from all over the world. As I was watching and chatting with some visitors, I found that majority of the people were either very nominal believers or know very little about the Gospel.

There was a day I joined a Korean mission team to give tracts and carried out street evangelism at Luton Town. It was drizzling and cold winds cutting through the air. Initially we were struggling if we should just cancelled. There were many people crossing us at the busy junction in front of the shopping mall and streets. We carried a big wooden cross to attract some attention.

After much prayers, we saw some people just walked aimlessly. We started approaching them with the heart full of the love of Jesus. Many came to receive tracts. Those who received tracts from us were mostly Middle Eastern people, Africans and Eastern Europeans. Quite a number stopped by to have conversation. We can see that the hunger in them seeking for truth and seeking the true meaning of their lives. We have a couple of university students who, from their dressing were from different faith, came to us with thirst for knowing more. A couple of them accepted Jesus as their personal Saviour.



TESTIMONY

I met one particular person who was fuming with anger about our evangelising on the street, and began pouring out angry and threatening words challenging our faith. I quietened him down by giving him back the burden of proof, instead of arguing with him. I find that my facilitation of Pluralism in Haggai helped me a lot after processing those materials through the sessions in Malaysia. Finally, we managed to discuss the subject of faith and Jesus calmly and intelligently. God, helps all these people, and all those who received the tracts.

That day, our team distributed about 400 tracts. None of the tract fall into dustbin. God is faithful, and we pray, every word that was spoken will not return back to Him in vain. London, we want to claim you for Jesus Christ, since we owed the debt of Gospel to all those missionaries who spent their lives here in Asia.



We attended a Church in Luton suburban with our daughter's family. We conversed with the Leaders about such a great numbers and proportion of the population whom we met are non-British, he told us with kind of despondent and helplessness that he just don't know how to handle the situation or mobilising the church to reach out. How pitiful! That inspire us that we must reach out to our neighbours who came from far countries and residing in Malaysia. The urgent needs of equipping and training are great. Pray that the Lord will send forth workers into the Harvest field.

Some years back, we came to London, and one Chinese Church asked us to help them in training their congregation in Personal witnessing and evangelism. We thank God for all these opportunities even though our time in London was always short. One day, we aspire to bring the good news back to London, not only to the diaspora, but also to the Londoners and British, where many have lost their faith. God, please rekindle your favour upon them.

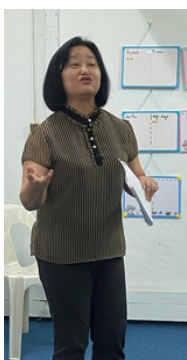
